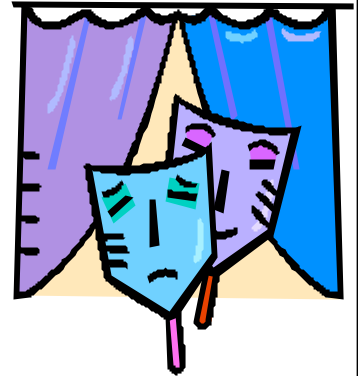

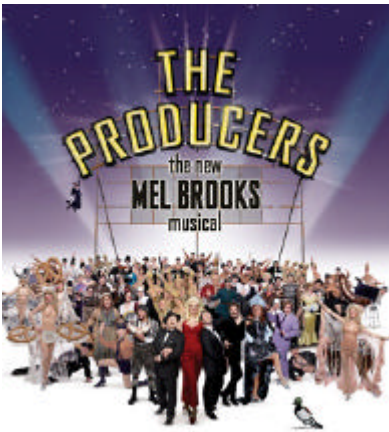
FUTURE PRODUCTIONS
