Northern Division Youth Festival

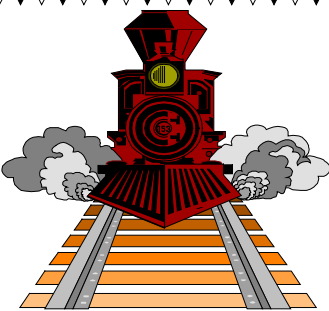
