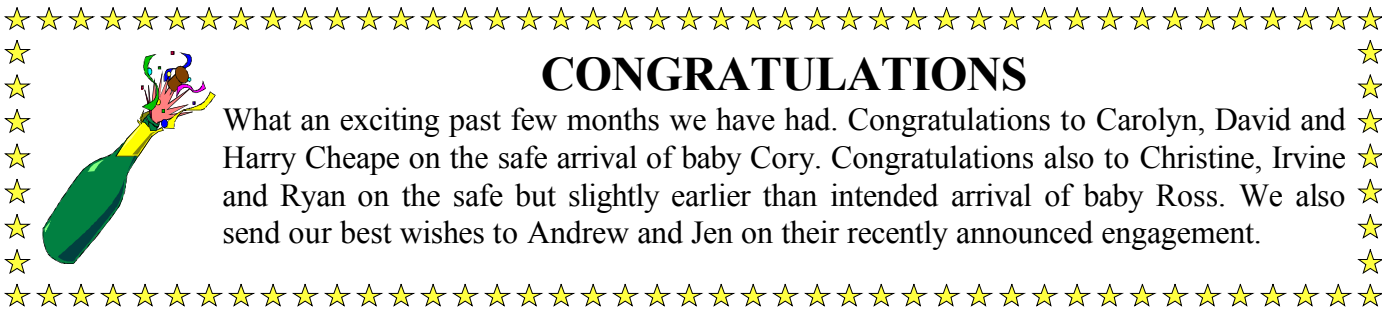

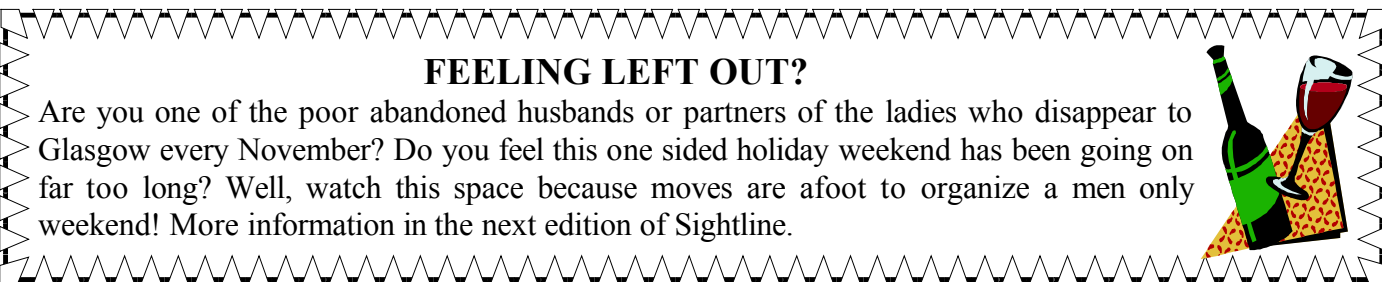

CONGRATULATIONS

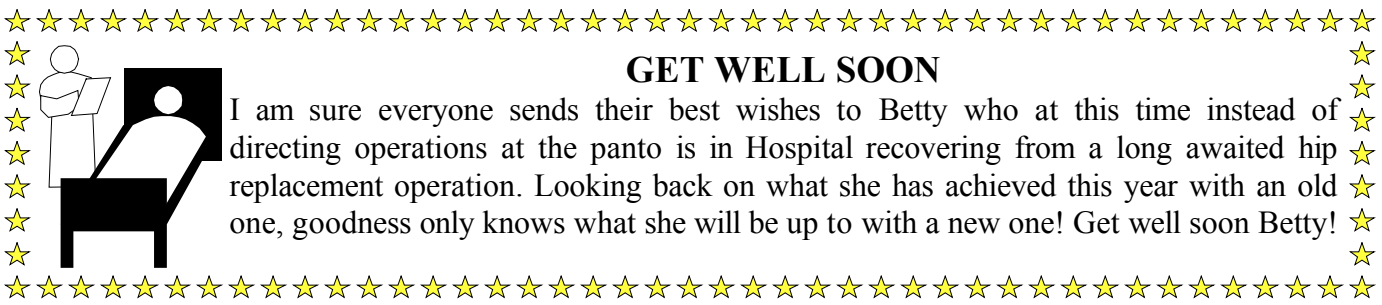

FEELING LEFT OUT?

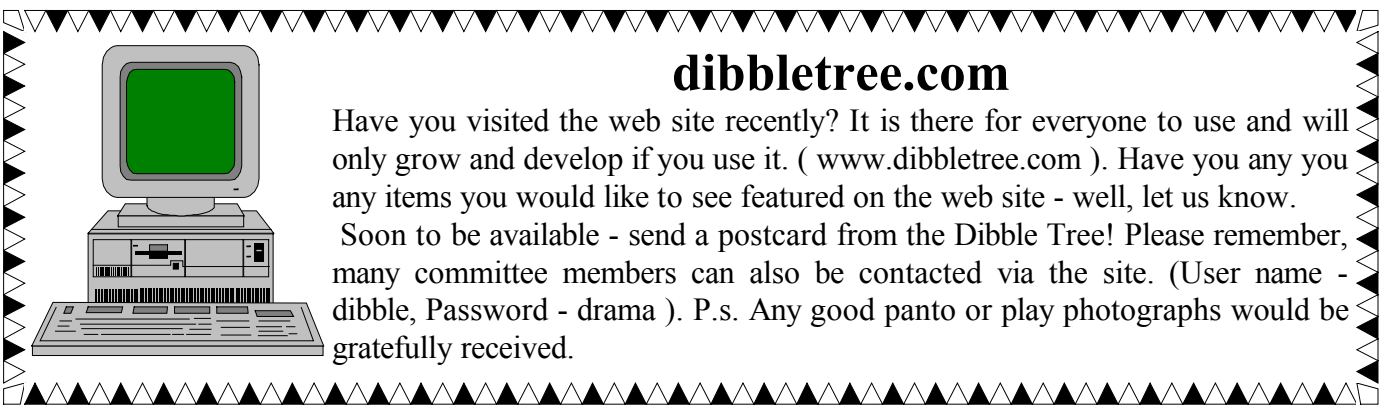

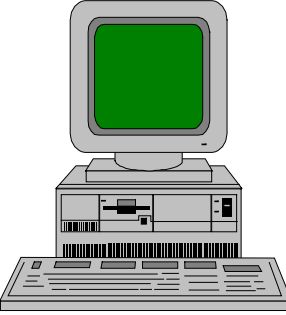
GET WELL SOON
