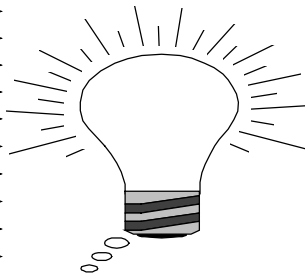

**CHEESE & WINE - ONE ACT PLAY EVENING**

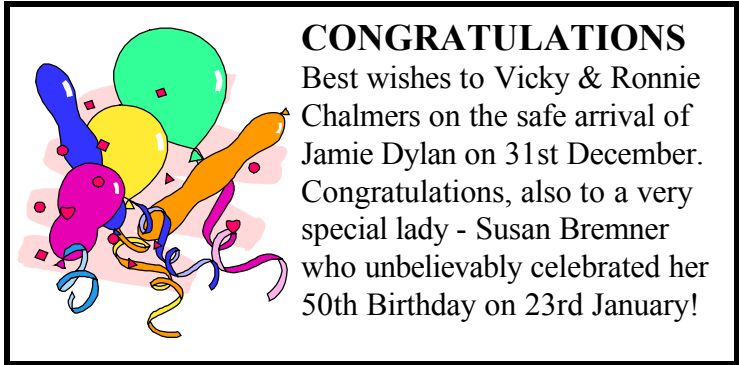

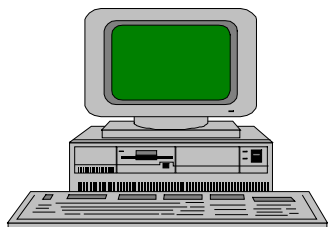
