## SCOTTISH YOUTH FINAL FESTIVAL

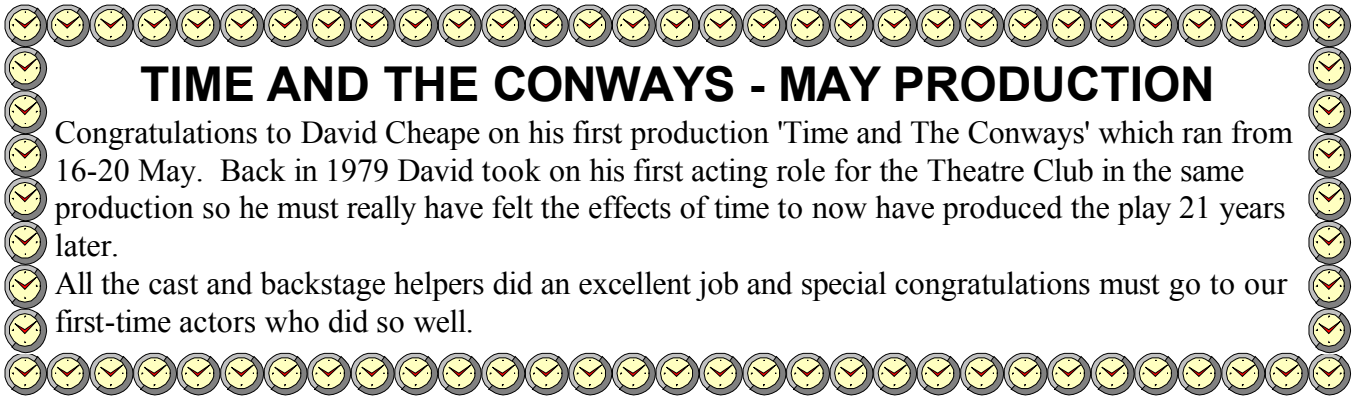
