The 2002 S.C.D.A. Angus District One Act Play Festival will certainly be one to remember. Not only were there the usual three days of great entertainment, but a Youth team swept the boards and took home four trophies! Best news of all, though, is that the successful Youth team was Carnoustie! Their performance of "Burn-up" by Derek Bowskill was described by the festival adjudicator, Tony Rushforth, as a "seamless flow of movement, colour, costume and sound, culminating in a quite remarkable achievement". Very high praise indeed! The team, as a result of their unprecedented success will be travelling first to Aberdeen on Saturday 16th March to compete in the Northern Division Youth Final, and then on to Orkney at the end of the month to compete in the Northern Division Final. They will be joined in Orkney by Kaims Players from Montrose who will be performing their award winning play "Janus". Kaims came a well deserved second in the District Festival, winning The Kay Fleming Cup.

Arrangements had to be made quickly to organise the journey to Orkney, as hotel accommodation for such a large cast and their families would be at a premium. A special meeting of all those concerned in the production was held on the Sunday after the Festival. The result of which is that a fully laden coach will be leaving Carnoustie in the early hours of Wednesday 27th March on the first leg of its long journey to Orkney! They will be there for the three nights of the Festival with their performance being on the Thursday night. Hopefully they will have time for some sight-seeing before returning to Carnoustie on the Saturday. We wish them all well.
