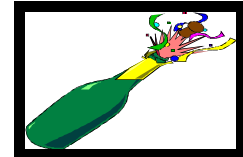
Panto 1999 isn't even over yet and already we are thinking about the next one! The committee welcome written applications for the following posts:-

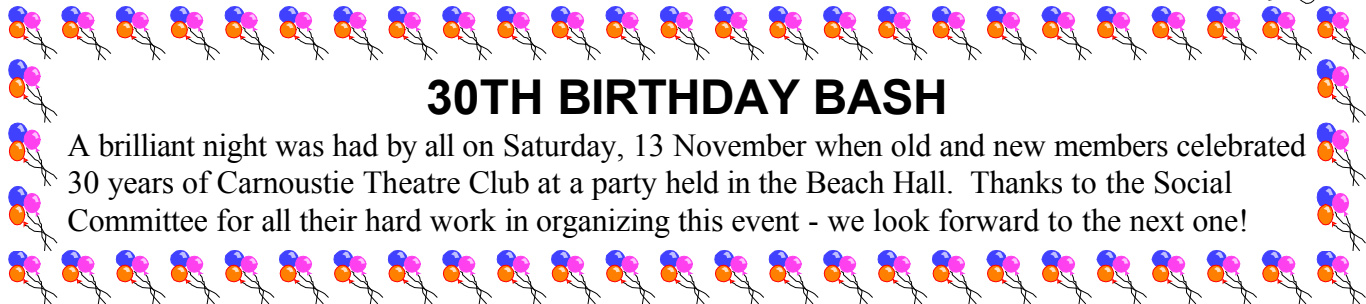

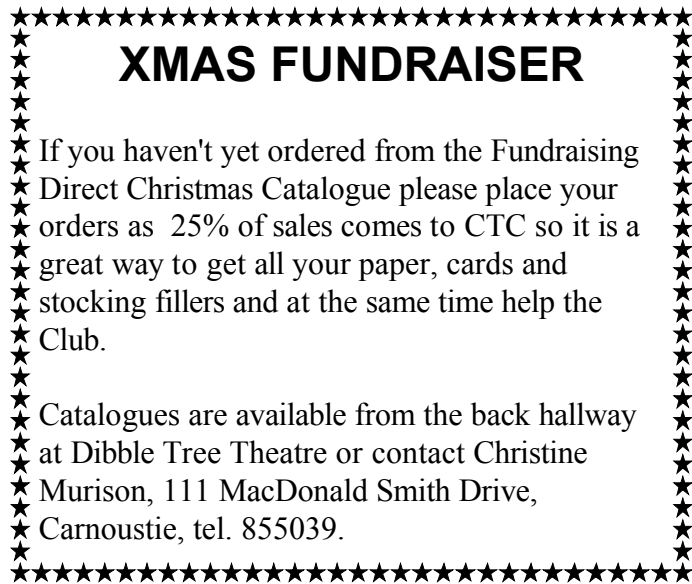
DONALD WHAUR'S YER TROOSERS!
