## EDUCATING ORKNEY!

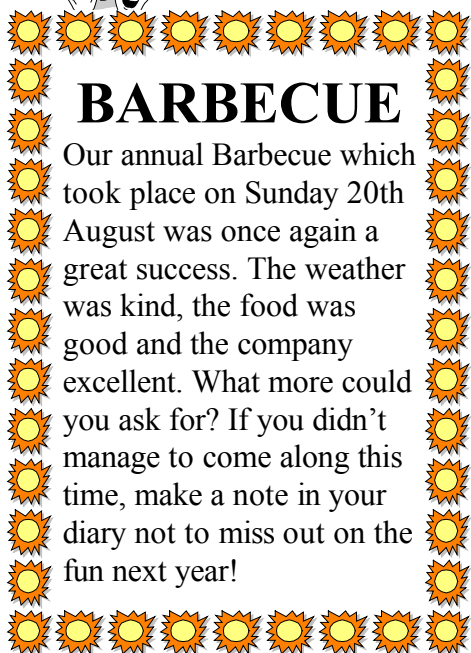
