FIRE DRILL AT THE DIBBLE

As is normal procedure we held our customary fire drills at the first rehearsal. This is to ensure that all new members are fully aware of what to do in an emergency. Although these went very well it was decided to reinforce the safety message by putting fire information notices on the doors of the rooms at the rear of the building and upstairs. This is in addition to the official exit signs required by law. However, it is vital to remember that if you hear the fire alarm sound, you **must** leave the building immediately by the nearest fire exit and make you way quickly to the front of the Royal Bank Building. Do not stand in front of the gates. Remember it might not be a drill!
